


The Western Ghats are awe-inspiring, with its dense evergreen forests, stunning bio-diversity and breath-taking waterfalls. Ensconced in the lush green foothills of the Kuduremukha National Park of Western Ghats region of southern India, Mala is a quaint, idyllic village. Although just 20 km from Karkala Town in Udupi District, it is miles and miles away from the hustle and bustle of urban life. Amidst its evergreen environs and intense silence, the rural agricultural life is an incomprehensible experience.

Mannapaapu Mane is a 200-year-old house built with locally available materials, later restored by an Udupi-based artist and sculptor, Purushotham Adve. It allows you to experience the nature in its fullest glory. With rustling trees, chirping birds, gushing streams and perpetual breeze carrying the fragrance of wild flowers. You cannot be closer than this to nature. There is more. Mannapaapu Mane is a home-stay as much as it is a museum – an impressive range of modern, classical, and folk art and artefacts adorn its walls and shelves. Mannapaapu Mane offers you an opportunity to enjoy the nature and the world of art at the same time.

# **Stay Tariff (per room)**

#### Note:

- Stay cost includes complementary breakfast only. Other meals are charged as per food tariff mentioned in next section.
- Total stay amount is subject to 5% service charges.
- 1) Deluxe Room 1 (DR-1; with private balcony)

  - Cost: ₹6,500 / night (base); Extra person @ ₹1,200 / head
- 2) Deluxe Room 2 (DR-2; w/o balcony)

# Food Tariff (per person)

• 2 meals, snacks & tea/coffee: ₹700

• 1 meal, snacks & tea/coffee: ₹400

• 1 meal: ₹350

• Extra breakfast: ₹150

• Kids above 12 will be charged full price

• Kids aged between 6 to 12 years, will be charged half price

• Kids below 6 years of age will not be charged

#### **About our food**

- We only provide <u>authentic Udupi vegetarian cuisine</u>.
- We use locally-sourced seasonal and organic ingredients.
- Our staple is unpolished raw rice (red rice) and parboiled rice (brown rice) which are richer in fibres and nutrients than polished white rice and of course healthier.
- We use organic jaggery and unprocessed sea salt.
- Please respect the food timings mentioned in the house.

#### **Facilities**

- All rooms have attached (western) bathrooms with heaters
- Access to high-speed internet (up to 50Mbps)
- Local taxi service can be arranged on prior request. Charges to be paid by the guest
- Vegan food available on prior request

# **Activities at the homestay**

- Streams and waterfall visit
- Forest trail hike, 4-5 hours (₹1,000 for up to 10 people; ₹1500 for more than 10)
- Kuduremukha Peak or Kurinjal Peak trek (it has to be booked through the Forest Department; we can only provide necessary details)

#### -> Optional, depends on availability of naturalist\*

- Late evening frog and herping walk (₹500)
- Night hike to the forest (₹750)

## Do's and Don'ts / Points to Note

While we would love for you to feel at home, please keep the following points in mind:

- Consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited in the premises.
- We only provide authentic Udupi cuisine vegetarian food. Please abide by the food timings. Your plates and cups must be kept in the sink after use.
- No smoking inside the house. Throw stubbed butts in dustbin only.
- Loud music and shouting/screaming are not allowed, as this will disturb surrounding wildlife and neighbours.
- There are lot of artefacts, antiques and books in the house. These must be handled with care and put back in their place after use.
- Practice <u>Leave No Trace</u> principles. Avoid getting single-use plastic bottles and packets. Any plastic bottles, covers, sanitary napkins and diapers brought <u>must be taken back</u> to the city for responsible disposal. Please ask us for disposable bags.
- We do not provide toiletries in an effort to reduce plastic waste. Please bring your own.
- <u>Avoid Geo-Tagging</u> photos of the streams and waterfalls on social media/maps, to preserve the serenity and sanctity of the place.
- Since our house is situated amidst forest and greenery, you might see some spiders/lizards/insects/snails/frogs in the house or bathroom. None of them are dangerous. Please do not kill them or harm them. We co-exist with creatures of all shapes and sizes.
- There may be other guests during your stay. Please be mindful of their presence and respect their privacy. Common spaces are shared by everyone.
- Use electricity conservatively by switching off lights/fan/heaters when not using them.
- Lights out by 11:30PM.

#### **During monsoon:**

- The streams will be gushing with water. All the rocks under water will be slippery. Please inform us before stepping out for a dip in the water, and we shall suggest safe places to get into the water. Extra caution is advised, especially with children. We are not responsible for any unfortunate accidents.
- Please do not carry any valuable items when going near the streams, as it will be hard to find things if lost in the water.
- When walking around, you will find leeches. No need to panic. Precautions will be suggested on arrival.
- It rains quite a lot here. We suggest that you bring an umbrella/raincoat and necessary weather-proof clothing according to your needs.

#### **Cancellation Policy**

- 1) 5% cancellation fee if cancelled 14 days before check-in date
- 2) 25% cancellation fee if cancelled 4-14 days before check-in date
- 3) 50% cancellation fee if cancelled 1-4 days before check-in date
- 4) 100% cancellation fee if cancelled 24 hours before check-in date

Note: Refunds may take 3-5 business days to process

### **Reschedule Policy**

- 1) No charges if rescheduled 10 days before check-in date.
- 2) 10% extra over stay cost if rescheduled within 10 days of check-in date
